



### NETWORK FOUNDING DOCUMENT "FAMILY FRIENDLY SPORT" PROJECT

In accordance with the shared values, goals and commitments set out in the previously signed **Memorandum of Cooperation**, the following members of the "Family Friendly Sport" project consortium:

are signing this Document and by doing so officially establishing the **Network of Family Friendly Sports Clubs**. The following provisions present a framework that regulates the functioning and enlargements of the network.

### 1. The main purposes of the Network of Family Friendly Sports Clubs (Hereinafter: The Network) are to:

- Ensure the exchange of knowledge, experiences, and skills that are necessary for the creation
  of an adequate environment for the multiplication and promotion of family-friendly sport
  approach among sports clubs.
- Enable establishment of partnerships that will contribute to the expansion of the family friendly approach and collaboration between sports clubs on a local, national, and international levels.
- Guarantee that the family friendly sports approach developed within the project "Family Friendly Sport" is fully and correctly implemented within its member clubs.
- Support the dissemination of the outcomes and products of the "Family Friendly Sport" project.

## 2. The Network will be comprised of two types of members - Founding members and Associated members.

- The Founding members are clubs and organizations that form the consortium of the "Family Friendly Sport" project. These members serve a role of the network administrators and are responsible for approving new memberships.
- The Associated members are sports clubs that will join the network subsequently.
- The membership in the Network is on the voluntary basis and members are free to cancel their membership at any time if they desire to do so.
- The membership of an Associated member can be terminated through the decision of Founding members on the basis of inactivity or the lack of engagement in the work of Network.
- The membership in the Network is free of charge.

# **3.** The Network is open to accepting sports clubs as new members. In order for a sport club to apply for membership it needs to meet the following conditions:

- The applicant for membership has to be headquartered and operate in one of the following European countries: Albania, Andorra, Armenia, Austria, Azerbaijan, Belgium, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Bulgaria, Croatia, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Georgia, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Iceland, Ireland, Italy, Kosovo\*, Latvia, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, Moldova, Monaco, Montenegro, Netherlands, North Macedonia, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Romania, San Marino, Serbia, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Turkey, Ukraine, and United Kingdom.
- The applicant for membership must declare its commitment to cooperate with other members of the Network, as well as to take part in the dissemination of the family friendly approach in sport.
- The applicant for membership needs to successfully complete the certification procedure for implementing family friendly approach, as instructed on the web platform of the Family friendly Sport project.
- The membership has to be unanimously approved by the Founding members of the Network.





















4. All members of the Network, regardless of the type of their membership, are required to adhere to the following commitments and tasks necessary for the proper functioning of the network. This means that every member will:

Take part in the meetings of Network members that will be held every six months in the online

Create and regularly update their profile on the Family Friendly Sport platform.

Appoint 1 to 3 people from their staff that will offer support in the technical management of the Family Friendly Sport platform for a period of 6 months.

Prepare and publish no less than 3 posts per year on the platform in a span of 3 year.

Suggest no less than 3 sports clubs that they believe have a potential to become members and will provide contact details for reaching them.

- Exchange of knowledge and skills by facilitating the free flow of information among its members, thus ensuring their growth and expansion.
- Forming of connections with clubs that share the same values and mission from all around Europe.
- Improvement of the quality of sports clubs' work and expansion of their offer through capacity building opportunities available on the FFS platform.
- Free promotion and increase of the sports clubs' visibility on the local, national and international levels.

### 6. The members are committing themselves to promote, disseminate and support the growth of the Network in their countries and internationally. This will be achieved by:

- Participating in the social media campaign for the promotion of the Network by sharing all posts produced by the communications team within the Family Friendly Sport project.
- Publishing a banner in their native language and in English on their website that indicated their membership in the Network.
- Taking part in no less than 3 panels/conferences/consultations/sports fairs, or other events within which they will be able to present the Network and its benefits to a wide array of stakeholders over a span of the next 3 years.

Organizing meetings with representatives of sports clubs that show interest in adopting a family-friendly approach and showcasing the benefits of joining the Network.
